The Hampstead Neighbourhood Forum supports this proposal to restore the railings enclosing the Holly Hill garden and outside the UCS Junior School. The Grade I railings, currently listed as “at risk”, are in a dangerous and dilapidated state and have long been the cause of concern to the local residents who look after the garden.

The proposal would sensitively restore this heritage asset, helping to enhance the conservation area in accordance with Hampstead Neighbourhood Plan Policy DH2 (Conservation areas and listed buildings) and DH3 (The urban realm).

We note that the project will be funded through local CIL and that the project received strong support in the Forum’s 2016 public consultation on CIL priorities. Both the Camden CIL team and local residents have put much effort into the project and we hope it can proceed without delay.
